What: Euro Quest is a unique blend of tournaments and open gaming.

Tournaments: Up to 11 different main event tournaments, expected to include (subject to GM commitment): Power Grid, Princes of Florence, Puerto Rico, Ra, Race for the Galaxy, St. Petersburg, Settlers of Catan, Ticket to Ride Combo, Thurn und Taxis, and one other as yet-to-be identified game, plus the Hot New Game, to be announced at the 2009 World Boardgaming Championships. Wild Card Event: A unique, free-form event including up to 15 titles. Games likely to be included for 2009 are: Agricola, Alhambra, Can't Stop, Caylus, Dominion, Goa, Pillars of the Earth, San Juan, Stone Age, Vegas Showdown, Yspahan, and a Hot new Essen game to be named by November 1, 2009. Note: This list is subject to change due to GM availability and due to the fact that one or more of these games may be promoted to Main Event Tournament Status.

Open Gaming: Dedicated open gaming space will be provided in the main gaming hall during the entire duration of the convention. Featuring the Euro Quest Game Library.

From North and South via Interstate I-83:

Take I-83 to Exit #17- Padonia Road. Go East on Padonia Road towards Timonium.
Turn right onto Padonia Road off the Exit Ramp and stay in the Right Lane.
Make a Right at the first traffic light. This is Deereco Road.
Holiday Inn (formerly Days Hotel) is the first entrance on the right.
Additional parking is available at the next two buildings past the hotel, if the hotel lot is full.

From North and South via Interstate I-95:

Take I-95 to I-695 North towards Towson. Take Exit #24 to I-83 North.
Go North on I-83 approximately 2 miles to Exit 17- Padonia Road. Follow Directions from I-83 above.

From the West via Interstate I-70:

Take I-70 East towards Baltimore. Take Exit #89 to I-695 North towards Towson.
Take Exit #24 to I-83 North. Follow Directions from I-83 above.
